- DO NOT INSTALL DAMAGED PRODUCT! This luminaire has been properly packed so that no parts should have been damaged during transit. Inspect to confirm. Any part damaged or broken during or after assembly should be replaced.
- Maintenance of the luminaires should be performed by person(s) familiar with the luminaires' construction and operation and any hazards involved. Regular fixture maintenance programs are recommended.
- It will occasionally be necessary to clean the outside of the refractor/lens. Frequency of cleaning will depend on ambient dirt level and minimum light output which is acceptable to user. Refractor/lens should be washed in a solution of warm water and any mild, non-abrasive household detergent, rinsed with clean water and wiped dry.
- These instructions do not purport to cover all details or variations in equipment nor to provide every possible contingency to meet in connection with installation, operation, or maintenance.

### WIRING INSTRUCTIONS & CONTINUOUS RUN INSTALLATION

This product has dimming functions. The three dimming functions that are available:

- 1. Constant current by 0/1-10VDC dimming.
- 2. PWM signal dimming.
- 3. Variation of resistance unit dimming.


#### **Standard Wiring Instructions:**

- L/live wire: Black
- N/null wire: White
- Ground wire: Green/Yellow
- Dim +
- Dim -

(As for the wire color of DIM+ and DIM-, please check the light label)


### Selectable CCT and Wattage:

- Press the screws on both sides of the luminaire by hand to open.
- CCT and Wattage can be adjusted with the internal switches indicated below.



#### Continuous Run Installation:

- Use the screws in the accessory kit to lock the bracket onto the first luminaire.
- Align the other luminaire to the bracket and lock the screws.





### **SURFACE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Based on the length you're mounting, drill holes at the corresponding positions and drive the rubber plugs from the accessory kit into the holes. (Figure 1)



2. Clamp the disc from the accessory kit to the lamp. This step can be skipped if the luminaire can completely cover the junction box on the wall. (Figure 2)





4. Lead the wire into the luminaire and install the chassis by using the screws in the accessory kit. (Figure 4)



3. Press the screws on both sides of the luminaire by hand to open. (Figure 3)




5. Connect the wires according to safety requirements and then install the luminaire body back to the chassis. By using an extra mounting bracket, lights can be connected in series. (Figure 5)



### **SUSPENDED INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Hang one end of the installation cable from the accessory kit on the wall or hook. Choose accessories according to your mounting needs. (Figure 6).
- 2. Fasten the other end of the installation cable to the luminaire. (Figure 7).

3. Press the screws on both sides of the luminaire by hand to open it. Connect the wires according to safety requirements and then install the luminaire body back to the chassis. (Figure 8)


